

Top Questions asked of Team Captains

The job of Team Leader/Team Captain is an important and demanding one. Team members will have questions, so we have compiled a list of the most commonly asked questions to help you in keeping your team informed

1. Does each teammate have to register? Can the captain register the whole team?

Each person needs to personally register and sign the waiver of liability; therefore the captain cannot register the team as a whole. The registration tells us exactly who is raising money for Mutual Ground and/or who will be participating in the Walk, and their t-shirt size.

2. I see something about raising \$100. Does that mean for the team or each teammate?

Each teammate can choose to pay the registration fee of \$20 per person or agree to raise \$100 to participate in the Walk. The team would determine their own fundraising goal.

3. What does each teammate have to do to earn a t-shirt?

Each teammate has to raise at least \$100. On the registration form, be sure to indicate size.

4. When are the shirts distributed?

Captains will pick up the team shirts on the day of the Walk.

5. How will teammates find each other on the day of the walk?

Teams should work out a plan in advance to meet together.

6. Can I add participants the day of the event?

Yes.

7. What are the event day logistics?

Walk For Hope is a 3K or 5K walk. It will take place at Waubensee Lake Park, located at Eola Community Center. Registration begins at 8:00 AM, with the walk starting at 9:00 AM.

8. Parking?

Plenty of parking is available on-site and at the church next door to the community center.

9. Do I turn in money at the Walk?

Yes, you may turn in envelopes and money on the day of the event, or send it to Mutual Ground, 418 Oak Ave., Aurora IL 60506. Checks are payable to Mutual Ground. Please have team members convert any cash into checks.

10. Can family members join my team?

Yes, anyone is welcome to join a team; however, each person needs to register and sign the waiver.

11. Is there a rain date?

No, the walk will take place rain or shine.

12. Can we walk in tribute to a victim of domestic violence or sexual assault?

By all means.

13. What happens if I collect money and then find I cannot attend the Walk?

If you raise your money on-line, it will all get to us. If you have cash or checks for us, please convert any cash to checks and send it to Mutual Ground, PO Box 843 Aurora IL 60507. Do not use the Donation Envelope as a mailing envelope.
